2. Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.

University commenced online classes from 16th March, 2020 by revising Academic Calendar and ensured prompt transition to digital mode of Teaching-Learning. The Plan ensured that the total hours of teaching & learning originally planned as per the course planning and credits required to be earned are not reduced/lost.

**BLACKBOARD**

The university conducted online classes through Virtual Classrooms via Institutional Learning Management System (LMS) "BLACKBOARD" already adopted by UPES in the year 2015.

The platform offers dynamic features as mentioned below:

- Blackboard Collaborate was majorly used for synchronous and asynchronous sessions. Lectures were recorded for students to review and listen offline. The platform offered features such as- Course Reports, Performance Dashboard, Retention Center, Email, Calendar Announcements, Course Structure Planning, Lesson Content, Weblinks, Links to media, Multimedia content development etc.
- Students could access features 24x7 on any device.

**OPEN LEARNING PLATFORMS (COURSEERA)**

UPES, collaborated with "COURSEERA" to offer a unique learning experience for students as a valuable addition along with the regular core courses to augment learning outcomes. Access to about 3800+ courses were made available with nearly 400 specializations to students, faculty and staff.

**ONLINE EXAMINATIONS AND ASSESSMENTS**

End Semester Examinations for Odd and Even Semester for all theory/lab/other courses covered in virtual mode (Non Graduating Batches) were conducted in Online Mode on LMS based platform, Blackboard.

The University conducted 2020-21 Academic Year, end semester examination in December 2020 and January 2021 for old and new batches respectively using more advanced Online Examination on proctor based platform CodeTantra.

**STUDENT INTERNSHIP AND RESEARCH**

The students were offered remote internships on live projects by the industry where they worked under the guidance of industry mentors supported by their regular faculty as internal guides.

**DOCTORAL PROGRAM**

The Pre Ph.D. Coursework Examinations were conducted through fully proctored Online Mode. SRC (Synopsis/ Abstract Presentation/ ODC/ Comprehensive Exam) were conducted online, where Research Students joined us on an Online Platform and made their respective Presentations to the Committee. Their Presentations and expert opinion were evaluated with the help of the SRC Software. Oral defense of Ph.D thesis were conducted online as and when required.

**LIBRARY**

- The University Library offered enhanced digital support to faculty and students in accessing various digital online e-resources, such as databases, e-books, e-journals etc. during COVID-19 situation.
