### 1. REGISTRATION

1.1 The participants must register themselves by filling the online form.

1.2 Registrations can be done simultaneously with the submission, but not later than the last date of submission, in any case.

2. **REGISTRATION FEE:** There is NO registration fee for the competition.

3. **ELIGIBILITY:** Students pursuing under graduate (3/5 year) or post graduate Law Degrees from any recognised law school/ university/ college across India.

4. **THEMES:** The article should be based on any ONE of the themes mentioned below:

- i. Gender Neutrality
- ii. Crypto currency
- iii. Data Privacy and Data Protection
- iv. Religion, Law and India
- v. Reorganisation of State(s)

## 5. AUTHORSHIP

2 Only one article per participant is permitted.

5.2 Co-authorship up to two students is permitted. However, the same shall be considered as single participation only.

5.3 The Co-Authors may belong to same or different institutions.

## 6. PRIZES AND CERTIFICATES

The prizes for the competition are as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> Prize: 10,000 INR and Certificate of Merit.

2<sup>nd</sup> Prize: 7,000 INR and Certificate of Merit.

3<sup>rd</sup> Prize: 5,000 INR and Certificate of Merit.

Alignment: Justified;

Margin: 1 on all sides.
